- Submitted manuscripts should be 4000-7000 words in length, in 12-point Times New Roman font, double-spaced, in APA-style, and with 1-inch margins.
- Please include your contact information on the title page (the rest of the manuscript must be blinded, i.e., without author identification anywhere else), then a one-paragraph abstract, then the manuscript, then a complete bibliography, all in one MicrosoftWord (or compatible) file. No author biography is needed at this time.
